

# NEWisconsin MRI Center Remote Network Access Instructions

1. Open your web browser (Internet Explorer – NOTE: Mozilla will not work!) Type in the address [www.newmri.com](http://www.newmri.com) and click on the Remote Network Log In button on the right side of the screen.  
\*\*Add the address of the new window to your favorites! (<https://remote.newmri.com>)
2. At the MetaFrame login screen, type in your **NETWORK** username and password (**case sensitive!**).

\*\*If you do not have the Citrix web client installed on your pc, you will be asked if you want to install it - click **YES**. It may take about 15 seconds to start the download. Clicking the refresh button on the applications window will usually activate it. Be sure to answer yes to any security messages.

3. Double click on the **Stentor** icon. If you receive the message "ICA client not found" or if it asks you to save the launch.ica, either the Citrix client has not installed or you need to delete your temporary internet files!

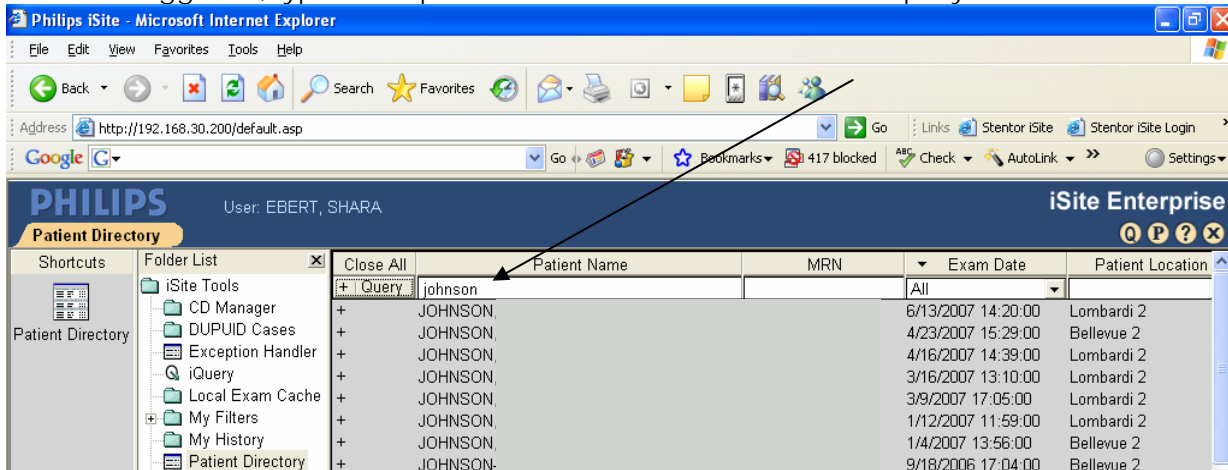

4. When the Login appears for Philips iSite, login using your username and password **FOR iSite**. If it is the first time you have logged into iSite, your password is the same as your username. You will be prompted to change your password and then log in again using your new password.

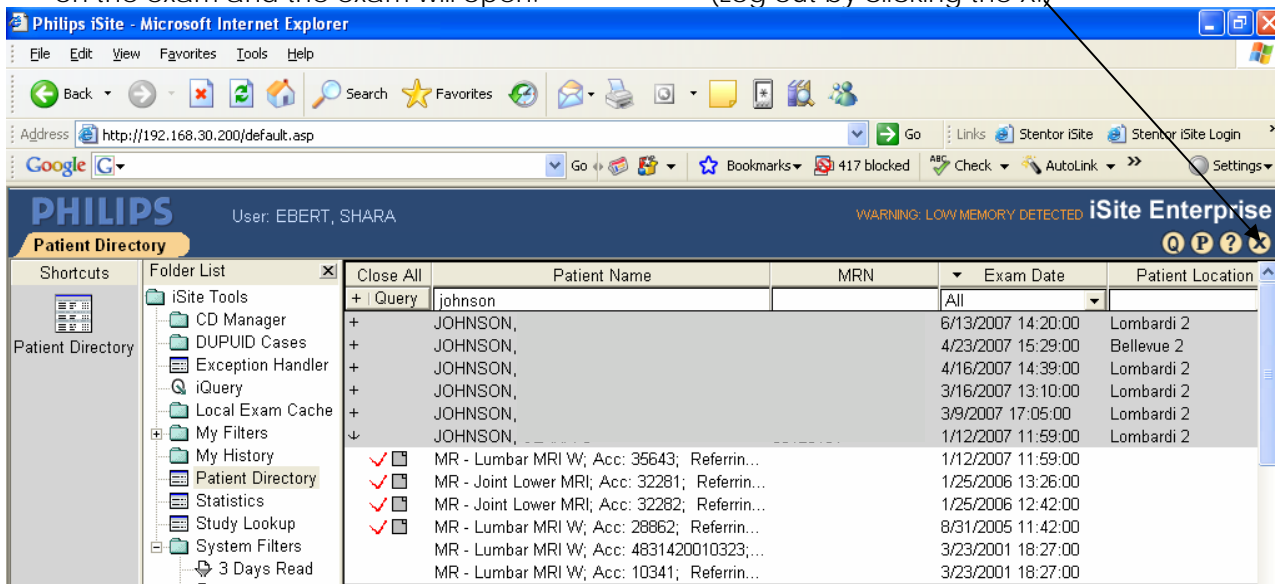
